Re: Emergency Rental Assistance Program Partner Agencies

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) was implemented to mitigate the impacts of the health pandemic by providing for emergency rental assistance to prevent homelessness. Since April 2020, Pima County Community and Workforce Development (CWD) has provided more than \$75 million in rent and utility assistance to over 25,000 households in Pima County.

CWD initially partnered with the City of Tucson to develop a centralized portal and contracted with Community Investment Corporation (CIC). The program was transitioned entirely to CWD on May 3, 2022. CIC also had a number of sub-recipient contracts with community non-profits. As part of the transition three agencies continue to assist CWD to deliver this program. These are Compass Affordable Housing, Family Housing Resources, Inc., and the Sunnyside Unified School District Foundation Inc.

The program has been successful in providing rent and utility assistance to the community in a timely manner. We will continue to do so as long as federal resources are available.
