Reminder; PCDOT process for non-maintained access to zoned homesites resulted in common 'standard' communications by staff & appointed officials over the past yearlong process;

- 3) no clear direction as to 'Owners' rights to maintain a non-maintained section of roadway leading to their property
- 4) no clear direction as to how to navigate the process to obtain approval to simply grade & place AB
- 5) giving priority to one property owner over another based upon length of residency Etc...

The Culture noted above effectively pits {neighbors, constituents, Citizens} against each other, and the process would definitely benefit from a redesign that places the responsibility on PCDOT to perform the work on this type of roadway (when applications are submitted to build). The Transportation Impact Fee charged for Building Permits (\$6,500+ in this case) should be dedicated to this cost as well.
