Please excuse my delayed communication. PCOEM has provided brief to our partner EM's Mr. Badilla, Mr. Sayre and Ms. Lynn as per our discussion February 3<sup>rd</sup> where we discussed FFY2019, FFY2020 and open FFY2021 SHSGP funding.

Overview of SHSGP aforementioned Investment Justification:

- 1. FFY 2017 and FFY2018 were de-obligated;
- 2. FFY 2019 is in process with ending period of performance slated for 12/31/2021

Discussion highlights with AZDOHS and DEMA:
Due to current COVID restrictions and the factors restricting our ability to offer training and exercised AZDOHS proposes the S. Region yield the FFY2019 award for reallocation to be executed by the SRAC in March/April meeting. This will allow for the time the funded IJ would require for execution. Any expenditures/encumbrances in the current FFY2019 will be moved to FFY2020 IJ allocations, within each designated County allocation.
The FFY 2020 will be opened and available through 12/31/2022. This will allow the S. Region EM's to wo with DEMA and local partners for prioritization and delivery of identified projects within the IJ. With this agreement, the S. Region EM's via Pima County Office of Emergency Management will not submit a FFY2021" South Arizona Multi-Jurisdictional Training and Exercise Initiative" application and hold till the FFY 2022 application window opens for submission.
These details have been discussed and is supported by all parties involved. We ask for confirmation and acknowledgement as a matter of record by reply all to all with concurrence from AZDOHS and DEMA. We the understanding that the South Arizona Multi-Jurisdictional Training and Exercise Initiative traditionally submitted on an annual basis will not be negatively impacted in future funding requests, nor that the non-submission of IJ for FFY2021 indicates a reduction in the need for Training and Exercise nor funding for the South Region.
We look forward to continued partnership and collaboration as we strive for a more prepared and resilient response community.
