First, let me tell you how much I appreciate your interest and willingness to follow up on my complaint with Supervisor Scott.

My husband and I are in our mid-'80s and go to sleep early, usually by around 8pm and sometimes earlier. During this past year we have been troubled by the noise of fireworks displays emanating from La Paloma, immediately to the south of our home. The noise keeps us from going to sleep, and our dog gets agitated and barks as a result.

We feel entitled to the peaceful enjoyment of our home, and feel that these disturbances must, somehow, be in violation of the law.

Again, thanks so much for your help in bringing this to the attention of Supervisor Scott and the Board of Supervisors.
