Dear Supervisor Christy:

I am writing you and copying the other supervisors about my concerns with Recorder Cazares-Kelly's proposed changes to in-person voting in Pima County.

According to the January 30, 2022 edition of the Green Valley News, Ms. Cazares-Kelly is proposing the following changes:

- 1. Reducing the number of polling places from 240 to 100. This is a reduction of over 58%. Ms. Cazares-Kelly states that this will make Election Day faster. I would suggest to you that this is numerically impossible. Assume a Pima County population of 10,000 people. If evenly distributed, that equates to 42 people in 240 locations and 100 people in 100 locations. That is an increase of 58%. I fail to see how increasing the load in fewer locations makes voting faster. Additionally, fewer locations means voters will have to travel farther to a polling location. District #4 is comprised of a significantly large older population, many with transportation issues. Fewer locations at a greater distance will decrease voter participation causing voter suppression.
- 2. I am concerned with the use of electronic tablets containing the voter rolls. The proposed contractor, Tenex, hosts its data on Amazon Web Services. Given the concerns rising from the

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2020 general election over electronic data, using Amazon Web Services appears to eliminate any checks and balances and leaves the data open open to hacking.

Voting is the bedrock of our Democratic Republic. Tampering with the system by reducing polling locations and potentially opening the voter rolls to third party companies without checks and balances weakens that process.
