Subject: Salary for New Public Defender

On April 19, 2022, the Pima County Board of Supervisors appointed Ms. Megan Page as the Pima County Public Defender following the resignation of the current Pubic Defender, Joel Feinman, whose last day will be May 2, 2022. Following a discussion with Ms. Page, I am requesting that her salary be set at \$146,004 per year. The Public Defender supervises a staff of approximately 156 full time employees (FTEs). That salary would be the same as Mr. Feinman's exiting salary. Ms. Page has approximately 2 years less overall experience than Mr. Feinman, but enters the position with 5 years of supervisory experience than he did not have when starting. This salary is \$14,271 (10.8%) more than the Legal Defender, who supervises approximately 50 FTEs, and \$31,004 (27.0%) more than the Legal Advocate, who supervises 9 FTEs.

I am requesting that this salary be tentatively approved by you so that on-boarding can be initiated for her into that position, which will then enable her current position of Chief Assistant Public Defender to be opened for applicants. Final approval of her salary will need to be made at a later board meeting as A.R.S. §11-582 requires that the Public Defender's salary be determined by the Board of Supervisors. Pending your approval, I am requesting that you present this to the Board of Supervisors for consideration at their next meeting.
