Re: Additional Information for the Board of Supervisors June 7, 2022 Board Meeting – Proposed Changes to Board Policy D23.6 Personnel Administration – Classified Service – Essential Training

Supervisors have a direct impact on the workplace to include effects on employee retention, turnover, employee morale, and productivity. In keeping with our desire to remain competitive in the market and invest in employees, I am recommending mandatory training for all newly hired and promoted supervisors to Pima County. The required training consists of:

- Four-part course in Fundamentals in Supervision, (within 90 days of hire)
- Management Essentials (within 120 days of hire); and,
- Conversational Capacity, (within 180 days of hire).

Current supervisors are permitted to take any of the above-mentioned courses, with the approval of their Appointing Authority. Additionally, the Ken Blanchard course of Coaching Essentials will also be available to current supervisors who wish to refresh their leadership skills. Changes to the proposed policy will allow for training opportunities, whether mandatory or voluntary, for all employees, both classified and unclassified.
