Cooperating Technical Partnership Agreement Program (CTP)

Dear Mr. Hendricks,

This is in response to your letter dated April 27, 2022, requesting that the current Period of Performance for CTP Agreement EMF-2019-CA-00019 be extended from June 29, 2022, to March 1, 2023.

We approve your request based upon your justification, including:

- There were delays in establishing Pima County Regional Flood Control District contracts.
- The size and complexity of the project area covered (over 29 Flood Insurance Rate Map panels affected) resulted in additional time requirements.
- The mapping for two of the projects is more complex than expected with respect to FEMA data capture standards, and the models take a long time to run.
- Pandemic safety protocols slowed down work processes.
