Grantor: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Emergency Food and Shelter (EFSP), National Board.

*Project Title/Description:

Federal Emergency Management Agency, Emergency Food and Shelter Program, Humanitarian Relief (authorized by DHS Appropriations Act) - Advance Grant Award in the Amount of \$3.25 Million.

*Purpose:

This 3.25 million grant award advances funds to Pima County as fiscal agent to cover costs of the Southwest Border Operations Partnership (Pima County, City of Tucson, Catholic Community Services and The Inn of Southern Arizona) incurred by provision of humanitarian aid to U.S. southern border Asylum Seekers.

*Procurement Method:

Not applicable to grant awards.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Overall goals are to provide humanitarian aid and promote public health. Outcomes: Provide food, shelter, and other humanitarian support to Asylum Seekers released by U.S. Department of Homeland Security agencies. Shelter provided is either congregate (Casa Alitas Welcome Center, overflow to Comfort Suites/Jot Properties) or non-congregate (individuals and families to Red Roof Inn/Jot Properties to isolate or quarantine based on COVID-19 positivity or exposure). Other humanitarian support includes support for Asylum Seekers to travel quickly and safely to their asylum sponosrs in other parts of the United States.

*Public Benefit:

Advanced grant funds allow County, as fiscal agent, to cover costs incurred by Southwest Border Operations Partnerhsip (County, City of Tucson, Catholic Community Services, The Inn of Southern Arizona) in provision of humanitarian aid to Asylum Seekers as well as to prevent street releases and prevent and mitigate COVID-19 spread.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Metrics collected for Grantor: number of Asylum Seekers sheltered and fed; average length of stay.

*Retroactive:

Yes. This \$3.25 million grant award allows County to cover costs incurred January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2025.
