Opposition to P20SP00002 River House Trust Proposal

I am a home owner in the Rio Verde Vista II association and wish to register my objection to the aforementioned proposal on the basis of an inadequate traffic plan which recommends changes to the park entrance from Craycroft Road and clearly has not considered the requirements of recreational and commuter cyclists.

The Craycroft park access road is the Loop pathway terminating point for northbound and eastbound cycling traffic on the northern side of the Rillito, and continued travel in these directions requires turning left. Changing the park exit road to a compulsory right turn, or alternatively painting a northbound-only left-turn lane instead of implementing proper traffic control measures is unrealistic and unsafe.

In addition, the proposal states that Craycroft is already over capacity, and that additional traffic will "only" contribute a 0.5% increase. Adding additional traffic to an already over-capacity road should disqualify the project from proceeding.
