Addendum Item #2 - RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 44, of the Board of Supervisors, calling for the repeal of A.R.S. Section 3108 and requesting from the Pima County Attorney's Office options to challenge its legality and/or constitutionality. (District 1).

I urge the entire BOS to reject this resolution.

Please remember that the Second Amendment of the Bill of Rights of the United States Constitution gives the people the right to keep and bear arms.
