Duration: September 12, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

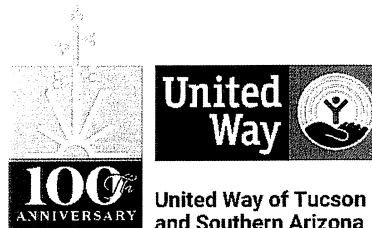
