Dear Supervisors,

I am opposed to the contract with Theelios, L.L.C., to provide for database management - Item 22 on the Sept 20, 2022 Agenda. Outsourcing for off-site management of sensitive County voting records in someone's home is totally unacceptable. You need to ensure the security of the data by retaining it in a restricted access building with monitoring capabilities. This responsibility falls squarely under the County Recorder's duties and must remain there - not in the hands of a former employee at his home.

Additionally, I ask that one of you question the Recorder concerning the process for removal of names from the County database when someone moves out of the County. I've been told that only the person that moved can request the name be removed from the rolls; that the new homeowner cannot report that the individual no longer lives at the address. If that is correct, the ballot will continue to be mailed and could be voted illegally by another individual. This needs to be addressed immediately. We need to clean-up our voter rolls to ensure election integrity.
