Due to the malfunctions and irregularities of our 2022 Arizona midterms, please hold off on certification of the canvass results until Cochise County Board of Supervisors receives satisfactory evidence and answers from the US Election Assistance Commission. We the People deserve for this process not to be rushed...and for it to be right. Confidence in our election process is at stake.

As an election day voter with no early ballot, I cannot even be assured that my vote was counted. The Marshall and Inspector at my polling location were giving out the slip of paper with a QR code to EVERYONE that day, not just people who voted early ballots. I only found out two days later after calling the Pima County Election office and recorder, that I had absolutely no way of knowing if my ballot had even been counted.

This is so disheartening and discouraging. Again, I ask you to please help restore faith in our system by delaying this certification and getting it right.
