### \*Purpose:

Amendment: Contract No. CT-PW-21-331, Amendment No. Three (3). This amendment extends the term of contract to 11/30/25, incorporates the scope of work and costs into Task D - Post Design Services for services during the construction phase of project, adds Subconsultant Desert Archaeology, Inc. to Task D for data recovery of cultural resources, increases the contract amount by \$366,607.93 for a cumulative not-to-exceed amount of \$3,492,988.42, and adds the Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs clause. Administering Department: Capital Program Office.

### \*Procurement Method:

Pursuant to the Emergency Procurement authority of A.R.S. § 34-606 and Pima County Procurement Code 11.12.060 as per the approval of the County Administrator on January 13, 2021, the Board of Supervisors awarded a contract for Requisition No. 21-071 on 03/16/21 in the amount of \$2,539,663.15 for a contract term of 03/16/21 to 03/15/24.

Amendment No. One (1) was approved by the Board of Supervisors, on 07/06/21, to modify the scope of work to include all elements defined in the Design Concept Report (DCR), add Owner Contingency, and increase the contract amount by \$586,717.34 for a cumulative not-to-exceed amount of \$3,126,380.49.

Amendment No. Two (2) was approved by the Procurement Director, on 05/09/22, to modify the scope of work to include all elements of the Draft Environmental Assessment Report as previously prepared by EcoPlan Associates, Inc. for Sunset Road: I-10 to River Road, add Subconsultant EcoPlan Associates, Inc. to Task E - Owner Contingency to finalize the Environmental Assessment Report, and with no increase to the contract amount.

### \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The Project consists of roadway and bridge improvements to connect Sunset Road from the I-10 Westbound Frontage Road to River Road, a new Sunset Road overpass structure spanning the UPRR right-of-way, new bridge spanning Rillito Creek, signalized intersections at Sunset and River Roads, modifications to the soil cement bank protection of Rillito Creek, and improvements to Tres Nogales and River Roads.

### \*Public Benefit:

This project will provide access to over 18,000 vehicles per day by 2045. It will provide access to the proposed Sunset Innovation Campus and alleviate congestion on adjacent interchanges providing the public with a more direct route of travel.

### CONTRACT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONSULTANT have entered into the Contract referenced above; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY and CONSULTANT have requested to extend the term of the contract and incorporate the scope of work and costs into Task D – Post Design Services for services during the construction phase of this project, which is scheduled to start in January 2023, at a cost acceptable to COUNTY; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY and CONSULTANT have requested to add Subconsultant Desert Archaeology, Inc. to Task D – Post Design Services for data recovery of cultural resources at a cost acceptable to COUNTY; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY intends to increase the contract amount to perform these additional services and add the Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs clause; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONSULTANT have agreed to the above modifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

CHANGE: <u>ARTICLE 1 – TERM AND EXTENSION/RENEWAL/CHANGES</u>, first paragraph, as follows:

FROM: "This Contract, as approved by the Board of Supervisors, ... terminates on March 15, 2024, ..."

TO: "This Contract, as approved by the Board of Supervisors, ... terminates on **November 30, 2025**..."

- CHANGE: <u>ARTICLE 2 SCOPE OF SERVICES</u>, first paragraph, as follows:
- FROM: "CONSULTANT agrees to provide Architectural and Engineering Design Services for the COUNTY as described in EXHIBIT "A" - SCOPE OF SERVICES (24 pages), EXHIBIT "A" – SCOPE OF SERVICES, ATTACHMENT 1 (12 pages), and EXHIBIT "A" – SCOPE OF SERVICES, ATTACHMENT 2 (2 pages), an attachment to this contract, and to complete such services within the term and value of this contract as it may be modified in accordance with Article 5. Amendments and changes to the Scope must be approved by the Board of Supervisors or the Procurement Director, as required by the Pima County Procurement Code, before the work under the amendment commences."
- TO: "CONSULTANT agrees to provide Architectural and Engineering Design Services for the COUNTY as described in EXHIBIT "A" - SCOPE OF SERVICES (24 pages), EXHIBIT "A" - SCOPE OF SERVICES, ATTACHMENT 1 (12 pages), EXHIBIT "A" - SCOPE OF SERVICES, ATTACHMENT 2 (2 pages), and **EXHIBIT "A" - SCOPE OF SERVICES**, **ATTACHMENT 3 (8 pages)**, an attachment to this contract, and to complete such services within the term and value of this contract as it may be modified in accordance with Article 5. Amendments and changes to the Scope must be

approved by the Board of Supervisors or the Procurement Director, as required by the Pima County Procurement Code, before the work under the amendment commences."

### CHANGE: <u>ARTICLE 4 – COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT</u> second and third paragraphs, as follows:

FROM: "The total of all payments to Consultant for services provided under this Contract will not exceed Three Million One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Dollars and Forty-Nine Cents (\$3,126,380.49)."

> "CONSULTANT's total CPFF will be allocated among the major tasks contemplated by this Contract in such manner that each major deliverable will have associated with it a not-to-exceed cost, plus a fixed fee amount, incorporated herein as EXHIBIT "B" – COMPENSATION SCHEDULE (58 pages), EXHIBIT "B" – COMPENSATION SCHEDULE, ATTACHMENT 1 (30 pages), and EXHIBIT "B " – COMPENSATION SCHEDULE , ATTACHMENT 2 (1 page). ### ADD: <u>ARTICLE 32 – FORCED LABOR OF ETHNIC UYGHURS</u>, the subsequent articles are renumbered respectively.

"Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-394, if Contractor engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, Contractor certifies it is not currently using, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not use (1) the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; (2) any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; and (3) any contractors, subcontractors or suppliers that use the forced labor or any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China. If Contractor becomes aware during the term of the Contract that the Company is not in compliance with A.R.S. § 35-394, Contractor must notify the County within five business days and provide a written certification to County regarding compliance within one hundred eighty days."

The Consultant shall make every reasonable effort to promptly review, approve or return submittals, shop drawings, Supplemental Agreements, contractor-supplied designs and proposals, product data, material samples, erection procedure plans and proposals for substitutions or approved alternates. The Consultant shall maintain a master file of submittals.

Kimley-Horn is formally requesting the addition of Desert Archeology to our existing contract for the above referenced project. This work was not included in Kimley-Horn's original scope and with direction from Pima County we added Desert Archeology to the project to complete this work. ### Cultural Resources Services for the Sunset Road, Santa Cruz to Interstate 10 (I-10) Project

Prepared by Desert Archaeology, Inc. for Kimley-Horn

Desert Archaeology is pleased to provide Kimley-Horn with a scope and fee for archaeological services related to the reconstruction of Sunset Road west of I-10 in Tucson. The project will be administered by the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and constructed with ADOT's I-10. Ina to Ruthrauff project. The planned project is located within a known archaeological site, AZ AA:12:788(ASM), a multicomponent site in use from the Early Agricultural period into the Hohokam Classic period that meets eligibility requirements for the National Register of Historic Places. Pima County sponsored archaeological investigations within the project area before the current alignment of Sunset Road was constructed. The current project is planned to be constructed primarily on fill with limited exposure of previously undisturbed deposits below the current grade. Consultation by ADOT under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act has resulted in a determination of No Adverse Effect for the project with cultural resources monitoring in the locations of planned impacts. This proposal identifies the tasks and costs for monitoring ground disturbance associated with reconstruction of Sunset Road within AZ AA:12:788(ASM).

### Scope of Work

During the design phase of the project, Desert Archaeology will make sure that all documents and permits needed for the project are approved and in place.

- Desert Archaeology will prepare a project-specific addendum to the Arizona State Museum (ASM) and State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) approved *Cultural Resources Monitoring Plan for Certain Maintenance and Repair Projects in Pima County, Arizona* (O'Mack and Boley 2010). The addendum will support Section 106 consultation and provide a description of the undertaking, maps showing where monitoring will occur, and applicable site descriptions and rationale for monitoring.
- Desert Archaeology will obtain a project-specific Arizona Antiquities Act (AAA) permit and repository agreement for monitoring within AZ AA:12:788(ASM) from the Arizona State Museum (ASM), and a case number under Pima County's blanket Burial Agreement with ASM to comply with ARS 41-844 and ARS 41-865, dated 19 September, 2012.

During and following the construction phase of the project, Desert Archaeology will monitor ground disturbance and analyze and report on the results. We will ensure that all deliverables and final disposition of project collections meet compliance requirements.

Desert Archaeology will provide a qualified archaeologist to monitor the subsurface excavations
associated with the project and contract with the San Xavier Monitoring program to provide a tribal
monitor to work with the archaeologist. Monitoring will include the following activities: a) the
archaeologist will coordinate closely with the construction crew to inspect the excavated material and
exposed surfaces for cultural artifacts and features; b) if cultural remains are found, the archaeologist
will document their presence through a written description and location mapping; c) diagnostic artifacts
will be examined in order to evaluate their significance; d) if significant non-burial features are found,
Desert Archaeology will consult with Pima County archaeologists and implement further data recovery
as needed; e) if human remains are encountered, all construction work in the vicinity of the find will be
halted until the feature has been documented and removed in accordance with the project burial
agreement; f) mortuary features and any associated funerary objects will be repatriated to the lead

claimant specified by the burial agreement. The archaeologist will work closely with the construction crew to minimize any delays and to develop the most efficient monitoring schedule.

Proposed field effort includes 40 person-days of monitoring over the course of the construction period and 30 person-days of limited data recovery to place test units in up to five non-burial features and recover up to three burials. Test units would be used to assess the architectural characteristics of the features and collect artifacts and samples from the fill.

- Post-field tasks associated with the monitoring and data recovery fieldwork will include the processing and analysis of field collections and preparation of a technical report that provides the relevant information about the project and evaluates the significance of any cultural resources encountered. The report will follow content and formatting guidelines established by the SHPO and the ASM.
- Upon completion of the project, records and non-mortuary collections will be curated at the ASM repository facility. Mortuary collections will be treated in accordance with the project burial agreement.

Cost Estimate and Schedule

Desert Archaeology's not-to-exceed cost estimate for the cultural resources tasks scoped above is \$120,106.96. The attached table provides a breakdown of costs. We can begin work on this project as soon as we receive a Notice to Proceed. The monitoring and discovery plan addendum will be prepared within four weeks and submitted in support of the AAA permit. Fieldwork can begin as soon as the AAA permit has been obtained (typically 35 days for a standard permit). Once all construction monitoring and data recovery fieldwork is complete, the project report will require an additional ten to twelve weeks to complete depending on findings.

Psomas is submitting this contract modification for professional engineering services related to post design services. Post Design Services may include, but are not limited to the following items:
