Title: Certification of School District Elections

### Introduction/Background:

The Pima County School Superintendent is requesting that the Pima County Board of Supervisors accept the certified School District Election results.

#### Discussion:

The Superintendent of Schools has received the official canvas from the Pima County Elections Department for the Catalina Foothills Unified School District No. 16 (override, bond, DAA); Marana Unified School District No. 6 (bond); Sahuarita Unified School District No. 30 (override, DAA); and Tanque Verde Unified School District No. 13 (override).

The Pima County School Superintendent is responsible for conducting all school district special elections pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-302(A)(8) as the elections will not become certified until the Superintendent of Schools declares the results to the Pima County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-481(0), 15-426(B) and 15-493, and that the Board of Supervisors accept the results pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 15-426 and 15-492.

#### Conclusion:

The Pima County Superintendent of Schools will present the School District special election results to the Board of Supervisors, which will then certify the results.
