*Project Title/Description:

Petco Love 2023 Spring Vaccine Campaign

*Purpose:

Petco Love is providing in-kind grants of pet vaccines to its animal welfare partners, which these partners can distribute for free to treat local animals. Pima Animal Care Center (PACC) is a Petco Love partner and requested 850 doses of these vaccines. PACC veterinarians will use the grant to vaccinate community cats (free-roaming cats living in colonies in local neighborhoods) at spring clinics hosted at PACC. The purpose of the clinics is to increase the number of vaccinated community cats and to decrease the spread of vaccine-preventable diseases should these cats enter animal shelters or come into contact with other animals.

*Procurement Method:

Not applicable.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

PACC veterinarians plan to vaccinate about 600 community cats and kittens at the spring clinics. In addition to vaccinations, the veterinarians will offer brief exams, free spay or neuter surgeries, parasite treatments, and microchip implants. PACC kicked off the clinics with a "Snip N Tip" spay-and-neuter event for community cats on February 24-26, 2023, before the start of Kitten Season. Free weekly clinics will take place at the PACC clinic in March and April.

*Public Benefit:

This campaign is intended to improve the lives of the vaccinated animals and to decrease the spread of vaccine-preventable, contagious diseases (parvovirus, distemper, and panleukopenia).

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

The number of community kittens and cats that are vaccinated.

*Retroactive:

Yes. GMI staff received the request from the department on January 24. Staff submitted the grant application request to GMI leadership on February 3. The final executed request was received from GMI leadership on February 13. The deadline for the Board of Supervisors meeting on March 21 was met. These clinics for community cats take place during March and April. To get ahead of spring Kitten Season, a kickoff "Snip N Tip" spray-and-neuter event took place February 24-26, 2023. Failure to approve this grant award will have a negative impact on Pima Animal Care Center's ability to provide vaccinations that help prevent contagious diseases and uphold public safety.
