The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

- 1. Background and Purpose.
 - 1.1. <u>Background</u>. On August 25, 2020, County and Contractor entered into the above referenced agreement to provide legal services to Pima County in *Taylor v. Pima County, et al.*, Federal District Court Case No. 4:15-CV-00152-TUC-RM.
 - 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. County requires continuing services and requires additional funds to perform those services, commencing March 5, 2024.
- 2. Maximum Payment Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 5.2, is increased by \$250,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$845,000.00.
