Petco Love Vaccine Campaign 2023		

*Purpose:

To reduce vaccine-preventable diseases in public-owned companion pets and in free-roaming/feral community cats within Pima County. The \$6,108 award total equals a combination of \$3,558 (the value of an in-kind donation of vaccines) + \$2,550 (a cash stipend to cover administering the vaccines).

*Procurement Method:

Not applicable.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

To administer free vaccines to public-owned companion pets and to free-roaming/feral community cats (via Trap-Neuter-Return) within Pima County.

*Public Benefit:

To expand access to preventative care for the good of the community and to decrease the spread of disease should public-owned companion pets and free-roaming/feral community cats enter animal shelters.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Track the number of public-owned companion pets and free-roaming/feral community cats that receive vaccinations.

*Retroactive:

Yes. Petco Love approved PACC's request for this vaccine in-kind grant on 8/8/2023. PACC held five vaccination events covered by this grant in September and October 2023. PACC's Grant Application Approval Request was signed by the County Administrator on 10/27/2023. If this award is not approved, PACC will have to repay the costs of the award.

Were there any challenges you faced while coordinating your participation in this campaign?

The national shortage of veterinarians/veterinarian technicians has negatively affected Arizona and Pima Animal Care Center (PACC). This situation has hampered our ability to conduct community outreach clinics because the first priority for our vets is to provide medical care to in-shelter animals. Fortunately, this year, we hired a Clinic Supervisor, a veterinarian, and several vet technicians, and we are currently recruiting to hire another veterinarian. Our recently expanded medical team -- coupled with Petco Love's generous in-kind vaccine grants -- has helped us to better balance shelter and community needs, and allowed us to more easily host community clinic events -- as we did in summer and autumn of 2023.
