ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION and/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - ____, An ordinance of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, establishing Prima Facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on Trails End Road in Pima County, Arizona. Staff recommends **APPROVAL**. (District 5)

The reason for this ordinance is to extend the 35 mph speed zone on Trails End Road further to the east in the vicinity of the Cooper Center for Environmental Learning.

At the request of facility director, a traffic study was conducted to determine if the speed limit should be lowered in the vicinity of the Cooper Center for Environmental Learning, a cooperative learning center for the Tucson Unified School District and the University of Arizona. In the interest of providing a safer roadway environment adjacent to the facility, it is recommended that the 35 mph speed limit be extended 1800 feet to the east. The speed limit on the remaining segment of Trails End Road will remain at 45 mph.



**AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING PRIMA FACIE
REASONABLE SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES
ON TRAILS END ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627, 28-701 and 28-703, as amended, to fix prima facie reasonable speed limits on through highways, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined the prima facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on portions of Trails End Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit for motor vehicles on Trails End Road shall be established as follows:

| <u>SPEED LIMIT</u> | <u>FROM</u> | <u>TO</u> |
|--------------------|-------------------|-------------------|
| a) 35 mph | Lost Canyon Drive | Placita De Laroca |
| b) 45 mph | Placita De Laroca | Camino De Oeste |

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2011-042 is repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highways herein listed giving notice of the prima facie reasonable speed limits.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
