FUNDING SOURCE: State of Arizona, Department of Housing (ADOH) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Colonias Set-Aside funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

FUNDING AMOUNT: \$146,000.00 **COST TO PIMA COUNTY GENERAL FUND:** \$0.00

PURPOSE: To replace a 2,000 gallon hydro-pneumatic tank, and install a new welded, above ground 20,000 gallon water storage tank, including all equipment, materials and labor, in the unincorporated community of Rillito in Pima County.

PROGRAM GOALS/PREDICTED OUTCOMES: The goal is to complete Rillito's water improvements project by assisting in the procurement of engineers and contractors. The predicted outcome is to create suitable living environments, as identified in the application for ADOH CDBG Colonias Set-Aside Competitive Funding, through the delivery of safe, reliable, potable water for everyday household uses and needs.

PUBLIC BENEFIT: The program meets HUD's Area Benefit National Objective to assist low- to moderate-income communities; Rillito is 100% low-income according to the most recent 2010 Census based Low to Moderate Income Data Summary (LMSID). Completion of this project will improve the water supply and access to the residents of Rillito, in Pima County.
