Funding Source: Pima County General Funds

Purpose: Provide Youth with additional summer education and initial work experience in a rural area that offers fewer employment opportunities than can be found in the urban area. The program mixes classroom instruction that helps each youth target academic areas they need to improve, along with work experience that helps them earn a wage and gain an understanding of the world of work. The IGA is for four (4) months.

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes: Increase academic skills of Summer Youth participants and provide work experience that will enhance entry into the workforce. 90% of the participants are expected to complete at least 93% of work and education hours, attain 80% proficiency in work readiness skills, receive at least one-half high school credit in one or more of the core areas (reading, writing, math and science) and gain one-half grade level as measured by pre-and post-program assessment.

Public Benefit: Increases Pima County's economic development by helping to develop a trained and productive labor force that meets employer needs.

- Completion certificates
- Pre/post testing of work readiness skills
- Pre/post testing of reading, writing and math
- Skill Attainment Record
