Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes: Assist homeless individuals in achieving self-sufficiency, stable housing and gainful full-time employment by providing case management, transitional housing, supportive services and education and/or employment opportunities. Seventy-five percent (75%) of all participants that complete and exit the program will have moved into permanent, unsubsidized housing.

Public Benefit: Reduce the number of homeless people in Pima County
