Program

Purpose: Provide homeless youth with case management, housing counseling, and housing assistance in order to stabilize their housing situation, and keep them in school while they progress towards their high school diploma; plus provide employment assistance after they receive their diploma.

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes: Assist homeless youth in achieving self-sufficiency, stable housing and gainful full-time employment by providing case management, transitional housing, supportive services and education and/or employment opportunities. Seventy-five percent (75%) of all participants that complete and exit the program will have moved into permanent, unsubsidized housing.

Public Benefit: Reduce the number of homeless youth in Pima County.

Metrics available to Measure Performance:

- Reports on rents paid by participant (with copy of check) as match on a monthly basis.
- Client information entered information into the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS).
