**Project Title/Description:**

Dental Sealants Program - school based strategy to reduce dental decay

**Purpose:**

This Dental Sealant IGA enables PCHD to provide dental sealants and fluoride treatments to children in Pima County schools where 50% or more of the children qualify for the free and reduced school meal program. Through this initiative, children in kindergarten, second and sixth grade with parental consent receive a dental screening, dental sealants, and fluoride treatment as needed. This funding covers both under and uninsured children enrolled in participating schools.

This Amendment is solely to change the vendor ID number under which the IGA is registered in ProcureAZ. In order to move the IGA to the main Pima County Health Department vendor ID number, the IGA/Contract number must be changed.

**Procurement Method:**

**Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

This IGA will continue to address oral health disparities in under served populations. Findings from scientific studies clearly show that school dental sealant programs work to prevent tooth decay and also stop cavities from growing. The Surgeon General's report on oral health indicates that sealants can reduce decay in school children by more than 70 percent. The Task Force on Community Preventive Services recommends school sealant programs and issued a strong endorsement in 2001.

**Public Benefit:**

Poor dental health can lead to pain, infection and tooth loss resulting in poor school attendance, low self-esteem, and difficulty with speaking and eating. Services specified by the Dental Sealant IGA are provided in Amphitheatre, Flowing Wells, Marana, Tucson and Sunnyside Unified School Districts. Without this funding, the Health Department would not have the capacity to provide dental sealant and fluoride treatments and many more under insured and uninsured children would have limited access to preventive dental health services.

**Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

PCHD will provide the following services in participating schools:

- Dental screenings and sealant placement (as needed) to at least 1300 children in 2nd or 6th grade
- Dental screenings to at least 600 children and at least 1200 fluoride applications to children in kindergarten
