Requested Board Meeting Date: July 7, 2015

Title: Repealing Ordinance of Abutting Crosswalk on Tetakusim Road at Settler Avenue.

Introduction/Background:

The Tucson Unified School District (TUSD) has proclaimed Hohokam Middle School is closed indefinitely, and has approved the removal of the abutting school crosswalk at Tetakusim Road on the west side of the intersection with Settler Avenue.

Discussion:

Through field observations, Pima County Traffic Engineering Division has confirmed Hohokam Middle School is closed and the Hohokam school crosswalk, while occasionally used by pedestrians, is not being actively used by school-aged pedestrians anymore. The volume of regular pedestrians is not sufficient to warrant the installation of a pedestrian crosswalk at this location.

Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering has confirmed that the TUSD Hohokam Middle School is closed indefinitely and that the associated school crosswalk is no longer in active use for school-aged pedestrians. As a result of no use, TUSD has approved that the County may remove the school crosswalk which will release TUSD of any contractual obligations to said crosswalk.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the school crosswalk on Tetakusim Road, west of Settler Avenue, and all relevant traffic control devices to said school crosswalk to be removed.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-___

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REPEALING AN ORDINANCE FOR AN ABUTTING SCHOOL CROSSWALK ON TETAKUSIM ROAD AND SETTLER AVENUE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-797A, as amended, to establish an abutting school crosswalk, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, passed ordinance 2007-15 on February 6, 2007, establishing an abutting school crosswalk, and

WHEREAS, the abutting school crosswalk is no longer necessary due to the indefinite closure of Hohokam Middle School.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

- **SECTION 1.** Ordinance 2007-15 establishing an abutting school crosswalk on Tetakusim Road on the west side of Settler Avenue is hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 2.** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflict.
- **SECTION 3.** The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
