Title: Workforce Investment Board (WIB) Reappointments to begin 10/01/15 and expire 09/30/18.

Introduction/Background:

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Section 107(b)(2) requires the following criteria for the WIB: **COMPOSITION -** A majority of the WIB must be Pima County **Business Representatives**; Not less than 20 percent of the members must be **Workforce** representatives; Must include a **Title II Adult Education and Literacy** representative; Must include a **Higher Education** representative from institution providing workforce investment activities (including community colleges); Must include representatives of **Governmental and Economic and Community Development** (GECD) entities; Must include an appropriate **State Employment Service Office** representative under the Wagner-Peyser Act; and Must include an appropriate representative of the programs carried out under **Title I of the Rehabilitation Act**.

Discussion:

The WIOA replaced the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) effective 07/01/15. The chief elected official(s) in a local area are authorized to appoint and reappoint the members of the local board of such area that meets composition requirements in WIOA. These 40 reappointments to the Pima County WIB will help the WIB to continue to meet WIOA composition requirements. See attached.

Conclusion:

All of the 40 WIB members to be reappointed meet the WIOA board composition requirements.

Recommendation:

Pima County Community Services, Employment and Training Staff recommends to the Pima County Board of Supervisors to approve the reappointment of the 40 WIB members.

Fiscal Impact:

If approved, the WIB will be able to fulfill the WIOA board composition requirements.
