Youth CareerConnect - Provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) training.

Purpose:

Develop and implement a two-year Cyber Security program for 11th-grade students enrolled in Yuma and Kofa High Schools. The program is aligned to prepare students for Arizona Western College degree and certificate programs in Industrial Maintenance Technology, Welding, Computer Information Systems, and to address requirements for local information technology and manufacturing jobs and trends. Amendment is to extend the term date. This is a four year program and there is funding available through 2018.

AMENDMENT


