**Title:** Naming of the Oracle Road Wildlife Crossing Bridge after Supervisor Ann Day

### **Introduction/Background:**

It has been proposed that the new Oracle Road Wildlife Crossing Bridge be named in honor of former Supervisor Ann Day who passed away suddenly on May 7, 2016.

### **Discussion:**

The Oracle Road Wildlife Crossing Bridge was constructed by the Arizona Department of Transportation and it is under their jurisdiction. There is a state process for naming geographic features and there is no known planned name for this bridge. Because Supervisor Ann Day was an advocate for the environment and wildlife it has been suggested that the wildlife bridge be named in her honor.

### **Conclusion:**

The Board can recommend to the State of Arizona that the Oracle Road Wildlife Crossing Bridge be named in honor of Supervisor Ann Day.

### **Recommendation:**

The Board of Supervisors recommends to the State of Arizona that the new Oracle Road Wildlife Crossing Bridge be named the "Ann Day Memorial Wildlife Bridge".

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA; RELATING TO NAMING OF THE WILDLIFE CROSSING BRIDGE ON ORACLE ROAD; AND RECOMMENDING THAT THE BRIDGE BE NAMED THE "ANN DAY MEMORIAL WILDLIFE BRIDGE."**

The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona finds that:

1. The State of Arizona has constructed a wildlife overpass over Oracle Road in unincorporated Pima County at milepost 84.8 and officially opened the overpass on May 10, 2016;
2. The State of Arizona allows for the naming of geographic places;
3. Former Supervisor Ann Day was a strong supporter of conservation efforts in Pima County and worked to preserve open space, trails and wildlife connectivity in District 1.

**IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Pima County Board of Supervisors recommends to the State of Arizona that the Oracle Road wildlife bridge be named Ann Day Memorial Wildlife Bridge.
2. The Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the County all application documents required by the State of Arizona to name this bridge.
3. The various officers and employees of the County are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary and desirable to give effect to this Resolution and request to name this bridge.


