Requested Board Meeting Date: July 5, 2016

Title: Appointment of Green Party Member to Election Integrity Commission

Introduction/Background:

On July 1, 2008, the Board of Supervisors established the Election Integrity Commission for the purpose of providing independent oversight of the county election process. Ten members are appointed; one for each of five Supervisors, one for the County Administrator, and one for each of four political parties recognized by the Secretary of State. Each Commission member two-year appointment is to be ratified by the Pima County Board of Supervisors.

Discussion:

The Green Party of Pima County Commission member appointment expired in February 2016; it was, however, inadvertently thought that the appointment expired in September 2016 due to the incumbent's reappointment after a several-month hiatus.

Conclusion:

In order to fulfill the Board of Supervisors' intent of a ten-member oversight commission for election integrity matters, the Board is being requested to appoint Mary DeCamp to replace the former incumbent Matt Smith to the Election Integrity Commission.

Recommendation:

Appointment of Mary DeCamp to serve a two-year term commencing on July 5, 2016.
