Title: Application for Treasurer's Deed pursuant to A.R.S. 42-18261

Introduction/Background:

The Board can apply for a treasurer's deed to property when a tax lien has been assigned to the state and not redeemed within 5 years.

Discussion:

The Treasurer has provided a list of 1,904 parcels for which tax liens have been assigned to the state and not redeemed within 5 years (the "Unredeemed Properties"). In order to have the Unredeemed Properties put back on the tax role, the first step is for the Board to request a treasurer's deed for the properties. The Treasurer will then follow the statutory process required to issue a deed for each property, which includes a redemption period. County Real Property Services will work with the Treasurer to prioritize the properties for which deeds will be issued. After a Treasurer's Deed is issued, the property can then be sold by the County pursuant to A.R.S. 42-18301 - 18303.

Conclusion:

By applying to have the Treasurer issue a Treasurer's Deed for the Unredeemed Properties the County can commence the process to get the properties back on the tax roll.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors apply for a treasurer's deed for the Unredeemed Properties.
