My firm, Wireless Policy Group, LLC has recently taken over this project on behalf of the Applicant and is working with your office to develop a design and location that is compatible with the surrounding area. I am writing to ask you to forward this request to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to continue Item 36 on the October 18, 2016 Agenda to the meeting scheduled for November 22, 2016.

As you know, the applicant has received considerable feedback from the community on location and design. In response to that feedback, the Applicant is in the process of exploring options to present to the Green Valley Council's Planning & Architecture Committee and the Planning and Zoning Commission. To facilitate this additional outreach, we are requesting additional time before advancing the matter to the Board for decision.
