This Amendment is made by and between Pima County, a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("County") and Goodwill Industries of Southern Arizona, Inc., a non-profit corporation registered to do business in the State of Arizona ("Awardee").

#### AMENDMENT ONE

- A. There has been an increase in the number of requests for Employability Skills workshops.
- B. County has reviewed the performance of Awardee and finds it satisfactory.
- C. County finds that Awardee has the capacity to provide additional Employability Skills workshops during the term of the Contract.
- D. The Pima County Board of Supervisors finds that increasing the number of Employability Skills workshops to county residents is in the best interests of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Awardee agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. <u>Section 3.0 -- COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT</u>. Paragraph 3.1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following paragraph 3.1:

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In consideration for the services specified in Exhibit A of this Contract, County agrees to pay Awardee <u>up to \$89,798.00</u> ("the Maximum Allocated Amount"). Funding sources are:
