Contractor/Vendor Name (DBA): Arizona Board of Regents for and on behalf of the University of Arizona "Tenant".

Project Title/Description:

First Amendment to Lease for the UA South Tucson cooperative extension.

Purpose:

Tenant has exercised their option to extend the term for an additional five (5) years as allowed in Section 2 of the lease. Tenant pays for utilities in excess of \$1,800.00 per year for water/sewer, \$4,800.00 per year for electricity and \$2,400.00 for gas in addition to their operational and personnel costs. Pima County is responsible for the utilities up to the maximum amounts stated above, maintenance and repair. The extension of the term of this lease will allow the Garden Kitchen Program which includes a nutritional teaching kitchen in addition to gardening and culinary education classes to residents of Pima County, to continue. Tenant has reached 232,730 participants and given 1,023 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program-Education (SNAP-Ed) lessons since fiscal year 2013.

Procurement Method:

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The Garden Kitchen will continue to serve the community by teaching cooking/food preparation skills and nutritional classes to make wholesome, nutritious meals on any budget. The nutrition education program was established in partnership with the City of South Tucson, Pima County, the UA College of Agriculture and Life Science, and the Pima County Cooperative Extension. The Food and Education Program, an intensive six-hour nutrition program for adults throughout Pima County had 236 participants which impacted 672 family members. The Healthy Living Ambassadors, a youth program funded through 4-H and the USDA, taught a total of 170 students nutrition and culinary lessons during the past four years.

Public Benefit:

Through cooking, gardening demonstrations and nutritional instruction, the tenant attempts to make a positive impact on the health and wellness of Pima County residents. Since the fall of 2012, the Garden Kitchen has supported 90 student volunteers or interns for regularly scheduled activities who have contributed 3,780 volunteer hours. In fiscal year 2016 through a partnership with the City of South Tucson and Trees for Tucson, a training program for Pima County adult parolees was conducted. Topics included landscaping and interviewing skills, financial literacy, stress management and healthy eating. A new grant funded program, "Cooking Matters at the Store" will provide grocery store tours that includes explanations of nutritional labels.

Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

The Garden Kitchen promotes healthy cooking and nutritional information which coincides with the mission of the Pima County Health Department to ensure the health, safety, and well-being of Pima County through leadership, collaboration and education.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEASE 2205 SOUTH FOURTH AVENUE TUCSON, ARIZONA

1. **DEFINED TERMS**. For purposes of this Amendment, the following terms have the meanings set forth below:

1.1. <u>Landlord</u>: Pima County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona (hereinafter referred to as "Landlord")

1.2. <u>Tenant</u>: ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS for and on behalf of the University of Arizona.

1.3 <u>Leased Premises</u>: The building located at 2205 S. Fourth Avenue, Tucson, Arizona, and known as the South Tucson Co-op, consisting of approximately 1,965 square feet.

1.4 Lease: The lease for the Leased Premises naming Tenant as tenant, which commenced on May 15, 2012.

2. **MODIFICATION OF LEASE**. Landlord and Tenant hereby agree to modify the terms of the Lease as follows:

2.1. <u>Extension of Lease:</u> Landlord and Tenant hereby agree to extend the term of the Lease for an additional five (5) years from May 15, 2017 to May 14, 2022 (the "Extension Period").

3. **RENT.** Tenant will pay One Dollar (\$1.00) rent per year during the Extension Period due to the nutrition, gardening and culinary education classes or demonstrations offered to the public.

REMAINING LEASE TERMS UNCHANGED. Except as modified as provided in this First Amendment to Lease, all of the terms and conditions of the Lease will remain in full force and effect and be binding on the Parties.
