Project Title/Description:

Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program

Purpose:

Engage in and implement collaborative, community focused, emergency health planning to address biological, chemical, radiological, or natural disaster events that result in public health threats or emergencies. This IGA provides scope and funding for FY2017 activities related to epidemiology, vector control, and emergency planning.

Amendment #2 adds funding and scope to address preparation for the Zika virus and other emerging infectious vector-borne diseases, and includes a reimbursement for an earlier 7% reduction in FY1617 Public Health Emergency Preparedness funding.

Procurement Method:

Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

- 1. Develop and evaluate effective local plans and build resource capacity for the Pima County Health Department (PCHD) to respond to public health emergencies, including local transmission of Zika virus.
- 2. Coordinate with community, county, state, tribal, and federal partners to build community preparedness and strengthen the Department's capacity to rapidly identify diseases, including the Zika virus and other vector-borne diseases, and initiate prevention and control activities.
- 3. Ensure effective, secure communication infrastructure for rapid communication between PCHD and its partners.

Public Benefit:

Increase in preparedness and capacity to address emerging public health threats and vector-borne diseases.

Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

- 1. Written plans that include processes for collaborating with public health, medical, and emergency response partners to address the needs of Pima County citizens affected by public health emergency, infectious disease and vector borne disease including Zika virus.
- 2. Coordinate with community, county, state, tribal, and federal partners to build community preparedness and strengthen the Department's capacity to rapidly identify diseases and initiate prevention and control activities.
- 3. Creation and maintenance of surveillance and investigation protocols, to include Zika and other emerging infectious diseases.
- 3. Development of Zika virus specific messaging, talking points, targeted educational campaigns.
- 4. Investigation, reporting, and response to cases of infectious disease in Pima County.
- 5. Department participation in training, exercises, and testing of state and local emergency procedures and notification systems.
- 6. Department participation in emergency response committees, coalitions, and partnerships with emphasis on redundant communication systems, resource support and sharing, early warning and notifications.

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2. Pursuant to Terms and Conditions, Provision 6. Contract Changes, Section 6.1 Amendments, Purchase Orders and Change Orders, The following terms are added to the Special Terms and Conditions of this Amendment Two (2).

21. Contracting; Procurement; Investment; Prohibitions

- 21.1 A public entity may not enter into a contract with a company to acquire or dispose of services, supplies, information technology or construction unless the contract includes a written certification that the company is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of the contract to not engage in, a boycott of Israel.
- 21.2 A public entity may not adopt a procurement, investment or other policy that has the effect of inducing or requiring a person or company to boycott Israel.
