## **Project Title/Description:**

"First Smiles Matter" is an early childhood oral health prevention and early intervention program for children, ages 0-5 years, and expectant women.

### Purpose:

In collaboration with numerous community partners, children and families across Pima County, from Vail to Ajo, will have greater access to preventive oral health services. Services that will be provided include: oral health education, dental screenings, referrals, and fluoride applications as indicated.

#### **Procurement Method:**

## **Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

Goal: To improve oral health outcomes of at-risk preschool children so they are healthy and ready to succeed in school.

#### **Public Benefit:**

Poor dental health often leads to pain, infection and tooth loss. The child with dental decay may have difficulty eating, speaking, and concentrating, which is likely to have a profound effect on development and their ability to learn. Without the First Things First funding, many under and uninsured children at high risk for tooth decay would have limited access to preventive dental health services.

## **Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

- 2,612 children, ages 0-5, and 60 expectant mothers will receive an oral health screening and referral
- 2,612 applications of fluoride varnish will be applied to children, ages 0-5 years
- 200 adults and 44 health professionals will receive education on the importance of early childhood oral health and simple prevention strategies
