Title: Pima County Workforce Investment Board (WIB) Recommendation for New Appointments

Introduction/Background:

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Section 107(b)(2) requires the following criteria for the WIB: COMPOSITION - A majority of the WIB must be Pima County Business Representatives; Not less than 20 percent of the members must be Workforce representatives; Must include a Title II Adult Education and Literacy representative; Must include a Higher Education representative from an institution providing workforce investment activities (including community colleges); Must include representatives of Governmental and Economic and Community Development (GECD) entities; Must include an appropriate State Employment Service Office representative under the Wagner-Peyser Act; and Must include an appropriate representative of the programs carried out under Title I of the Rehabilitation Act. In addition, other One-Stop Partners who receive federal workforce funds are encouraged to apply for WIB membership. Applications are vetted by the WIB Board Development Committee.

Discussion:

1. Alex Horvath, Tucson Medical Center, is applying to replace Julia Strange in the Business category. 2. Fred G. Acosta Job Corps Center is a federal workforce Partner and Brad McCormick, Fred G. Acosta Job Corps Center, is applying to replace Carld Rosborough. 3. Bev Price left her former employer HealthTrio and now works at Alorica. Bev Price, Alorica, is applying to fill the Business category vacancy that she created.

Conclusion:

If approved: 1. Alex Horvath, Tucson Medical Center, will replace Julia Strange and his Term will be 05/16/17 to 09/30/19. **2.** Brad McCormick, Fred G. Acosta Job Corps Center, will replace Carld Rosborough and his Term will be 05/16/17 to 09/30/18. **3.** Bev Price, Alorica, will fill the Business vacancy that she created and her Term will be 05/16/17 to 09/30/20.
