Requested Board Meeting Date: June 6, 2017

Title: Sycamore Leaf Road Pedestrian Crosswalk Ordinance

## Introduction/Background:

A pedestrian crosswalk is currently installed on Sycamore Leaf Road approximately 500 feet north of Rustling Leaf Trail. The crosswalk was installed as part of a development project for Sycamore Canyon in Vail and was not properly ordinanced.

### Discussion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering conducted a crosswalk study which confirmed that the existing crosswalk connects two pathways on each side of Sycamore Leaf Road. The pedestrian crosswalk is installed atop a speed table with a red brick treatment. Associated advance pedestrian warning signs and those at the crosswalk are currently installed.

#### Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends the existing pedestrian crosswalk remain. The pedestrian crosswalk provides a connection between pathways and residences on each side of Sycamore Leaf Road.

## ORDINANCE NO. 2017-\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING A PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK ON SYCAMORE LEAF ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-791, as amended, to establish pedestrian crosswalks, and when needed to accommodate pedestrian traffic, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is necessary for the protection of pedestrians to establish a crosswalk on Sycamore Leaf Road,

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

- **SECTION 1.** A pedestrian crosswalk is hereby established on Sycamore Leaf Road approximately 500 feet north of Rustling Leaf Trail.
- **SECTION 2.** All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that the pedestrian crosswalk is installed on Sycamore Leaf Road.
- **SECTION 4.** Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

**SECTION 5.** The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
