Requested Board Meeting Date: June 20, 2017

Title: Resolutions for Adopting Improvement District Fiscal Year 2017-18 Property Tax Levies

#### Introduction/Background:

Staff requests that the Pima County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Directors of the Improvement Districts receive Resolutions for the adoption of the following Improvement District Fiscal Year 2017-18 Property Tax Levies; hold a public hearing; and review and adopt the final budgets for Fiscal Year 2017-18 for the Improvement Districts.

#### Discussion:

On May 23, 2017, the Board adopted the tentative Fiscal Year 2017-18 levies for each District totaling \$179,486 in revenues, and set June 20, 2017 as the public hearing date thereof.

#### Conclusion:

If the Board does not hold the public hearings and does not pass each District resolution adopting the fiscal year budgets, then the Pima County Improvement Districts will not be able to levy the property taxes to pay for maintaining Hayhook Ranch Road and purchasing electricity for the 21 Street Lighting Districts.

#### Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Pima County Board of Supervisors acting as the Board of Directors of the Improvement Districts hold the public hearings on the District budgets, and pass and adopt each District resolution for adopting the District final budgets for Fiscal Year 2017-18 for a total of \$179,486.

#### **Fiscal Impact:**

Revenue to Pima County of \$179,486 from Fiscal Year 2017-18 Property Tax Levies and Improvement District Fund Balances.
