Title: Resolution Authorizing Pima County to Condemn for Pantano Wash: Craycroft to Ft. Lowell

Introduction/Background:

Pima County plans to construct and maintain "The Loop" as an alternative form of transportation and recreational amenity along the Pantano Wash between Craycroft Road and Fort Lowell Road (the "Project") and requires certain interests in real property for the Project.

Discussion:

In the event the real property interests for the Project cannot be acquired through timely negotiations, Pima County may have to exercise its powers of eminent domain to acquire the necessary interests to construct the Project.

Conclusion:

The Pima County Attorney will be authorized to institute condemnation proceedings to acquire real property interests where necessary for the Project.
