## \*Project Title/Description:

Youth CareerConnect - Provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) training. The original contract and amendments may be found under CT-14\*539. Search contract number 14%539 in eContracts.

## \*Purpose:

Yuma Private Industry Council will develop and implement a two-year Cyber Security program for 11<sup>th</sup>-grade students enrolled in Yuma and Kofa High Schools. The program is aligned to prepare students for Arizona Western College degree and certificate programs in Industrial Maintenance Technology, Welding, Computer Information Systems, and to address requirements for local information technology and manufacturing jobs and trends. This program and contract was initiated before the new Uniform Grant Guidance (UGG) went into effect so this amendment is to modify the terms of the contract to include the UGG requirements.

#### \*Procurement Method:

County applied for a Youth CareerConnect grant for the U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration and the County was awarded \$5,351,690.00. Yuma Private Industry Council was a partner in the application.

## \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

Yuma Private Industry Council was awarded \$484,289.00 for four years to provide case management and support services for 223 youth.

## \*Public Benefit:

Support economic development efforts by helping to develop a trained and productive labor force that meets regional employers' needs.

## \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Quarterly progress reports and a final program report.

Pima County a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona ("County") and Yuma Private Industry Council ("Contractor") have entered into the above reference contract to implement the Youth CareerConnect program.

# AMENDMENT NO. 4

- A. County, as Grantee, received federal Youth CareerConnect ("YCC") grant funds to provide workforce development services for youth. The YCC grant ends September 30, 2018.
- B. Contractor is a Subrecipient of YCC grant funds.
- C. The issuance of new Office of Management and Budget Circulars regulations requires a modification to the terms of this Agreement.

# NOW, THEREFORE, County and Yuma Private Industry Council agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

#### 1. ARTICLE VI – COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS, is amended as follows:

- 1.1. **Paragraph B** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
  - B. Contractor warrants that YCC funds provided for personnel employed in the administration of the program funded under this Agreement will not be used for:
    - 1. Political activities;
    - 2. Inherently religious activities;
    - 3. Lobbying;
    - 4. Political patronage; or
    - 5. Nepotism activities.
- 1.2. Paragraph C is added to read:
  - C. Contractor will comply with the applicable provisions of:
    - 1. Davis-Bacon Act (Pub. L.107-217), (40 U.S.C. §§ 276a to 276a-7) as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5) as amended;
    - 2. Copeland Anti-Kick Back Act (18 USC 874 et seq.);
    - 3. Arizona Address Confidentiality Program (A.R.S. § 41-161 et seq.);
    - 4. Uniform Administrative Requirements (29 CFR Parts 95 and 97);
    - 5. Fingerprinting, certification, and criminal background checks including, but not limited to the applicable provisions of: A.R.S. §§ 8-804, 36-594.01, 36-3008, 41-1964, and 46-141;
    - Clean Air and Clean Water Act (42 U.S.C.1857(h), section 508 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1368) Executive Order 11738, and Environmental Protection Agency regulations (40 CFR part 15);
    - 7. Energy Policy and Conservation Act (Pub. L. 94-163, 89 Stat. 871);
    - Debt Collection and Audit Resolution (Pub. L. 105-220 Sections 128, 133, and 184; 20 CFR Part 652, Subpart D,E and G; 20 CFR Part 667 Subparts D H; 29 CFR Parts 95, 96, 97, and 99; OMB Circular A-21; 2 CFR 200 and all subparts; Federal Acquisition Regulation 97-03 Part 31.);
    - 9. Child Labor Laws (A.R.S. §23-230 et seq.);
    - 10. Debarment and Suspension (29 CFR Part 98 and Executive Order 12549);
    - 11. Environmental Tobacco Smoke (Pub. L. 103-227, Part C);
    - 12. Nondiscrimination and Equal Opportunity Requirements pursuant 29 CFR Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 36 and 37.
    - 13. Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Pub.L.113-128; and
    - 14. All rules and regulations applicable to the Acts set forth above.
