#### \*Contractor/Vendor Name/Grantor (DBA):

Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Board (First Things First)

#### \*Project Title/Description:

Child Care Health Consultation (to provide services to child care providers in Pima County)

#### \*Purpose:

Health and safety consultation services to child care centers and child care homes in Pima County.

Amendment #4 adds \$4,480 in funding to serve two additional child care centers.

#### \*Procurement Method:

Grant award - procurement exempt per BOS Policy D29.4.V

# \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

This program creates healthier and safer environments for out of home child care, for both typically developing young children and children with special health care needs. Areas of focus include SIDS risk reduction, prevention and control of communicable diseases, immunization and medication administration, oral health promotion, building and physical premises safety and injury prevention, child abuse/neglect identification and prevention, nutrition and physical activity interventions to reduce obesity in young children, sensory and developmental screening, and referrals for families without access to health care or in need of other health-related services.

#### \*Public Benefit:

More than 45,000 children ages 0-5 in Pima County regularly require child care while their parent(s), grandparents or foster parents go to work or school or need respite. With large numbers of young children in non-parental care, children's health and safety out-of-home is an essential component of supporting children's physical, cognitive and social-emotional development. This contract supports Pima County Public Health Nurses and a Dietitian specifically prepared as Child Care Health Consultants to provide information, training, and technical assistance to guide child care programs in creating healthy and safe environments, as well as preparing child care staff to provide hearing, vision, developmental and obesity screening for the children in their care. With healthy young children in quality child care, parents miss less work or school and children enter the school system ready to learn.

### \*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

1. Numbers of child care visits, trainings and participant numbers; 2. Changes in knowledge, behavior and status for 13 health and safety-related topics (such as child abuse and neglect, communicable disease, growth and development, physical activity, and nutrition) are measured every 90 days throughout the consultation process; 3. Annual evaluations of health and safety criteria are observed by outside evaluators hired by First Things First; 4. Annual use of the California Childcare Health Program Health and Safety Checklist as required by First Things First; and 5. Annual Immunization Data Reports submitted by licensed child care programs to Pima County Health Department's Vaccine Preventable Disease program. Performance measurements are used to refocus consultation or select additional consultation strategies.

## \*Retroactive:

Yes. Amendment takes effect on 10/01/2017 but was not received by the County until 10/11/2017. If not approved, the Health Department will not receive \$4,480 to work with two additional centers.

#### PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT:

Pursuant to First Things First Uniform Terms and Conditions, "Amendments", of the above referenced Grant Agreement/Contract Award, the State of Arizona hereby exercises its sole option to amend the contract as follows:

1. Description of Services – This amendment is to provide additional funding that will be used to provide Child Care Health Consultation (CCHC) services to an additional 2 centers participating in Quality First through the Preschool Development Grant with ADE (Arizona Department of Education).

The total FY18 service units for ADE funded centers are 8 centers.

- 2. Manner of Financing This amendment adds \$4,480 to the current award to fund the additional 2 centers through the Preschool Development Grant with ADE for the remainder of the state fiscal year concluding on June 30, 2018. (\$474,880 regional funding and \$17,920 ADE funding).
- 3. The total FY18 grant award is increased from \$488,320 to \$492,800.
- 4. For auditing purposes, we are required to supply the following information relating to the ADE PDG funding: Federal Award ID Number S419A150009 ISA CFDA # 84.419A Total Federal Amount Awarded \$17,920
- 5. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
