9. What are you trying to achieve and in what timeframe?

With your support, we will pilot a year-long program to provide critically needed transportation, boarding, and veterinary assistance to elderly pet owners so they can keep their pets, instead of surrender them to the shelter.

Our Pet Support Center is a phone bank that operates 7 days a week, providing pet owners with advice, support, and alternatives to surrendering their pet to us. Grants and donations fund the staff members who manage this pilot program, and donations also underwrite a Keep Families Together Fund. This fund pays for owned pets' medical care and behavioral supports so these pets do not have to answer the shelter.

Despite these resources, our Pet Support Center staff members have found that we are still unable to assist many older pet owners who call for help. Pima County, Arizona, is an aging population, and according to the Pima Council on Aging, many seniors struggle with transportation, a service that we currently don't have the resources to provide.

Seniors who call our Pet Support Center report that they have no way to take their pets to the vet for routine preventative care, or for help with treatable conditions. This grant would help us provide transportation for these seniors so they could get to the vet, where our other grant funding would help cover those veterinary costs.

Additionally, we receive calls from many senior community members who need to admit their pet because they are facing temporary hospitalization, and they have nowhere else to turn. Your grant could help us vaccinate these pets, so they are boarding-ready, and it could help us pay for the temporary boarding needed for these pets while their owners grow healthy enough to care for them.

10. How will you measure or evaluate your success?

We will measure our success by the number of senior pet owners who were served through this program, and the number of pets who were able to stay with their senior owners instead of enter our shelter.
