*Project Title/Description:

Dental Sealants Program - school based strategy to reduce dental decay. The revenue amount depends upon the number of services provided. This amendment adds \$100/child for the application of silver diamine fluoride to the price sheet, enabling the Pima County Health Department (PCHD) to be able to bill for that service.

*Purpose:

This Dental Sealant IGA enables PCHD to provide dental sealants and fluoride treatments to children in Pima County schools where 50% or more of the children qualify for the free and reduced school meal program. Through this initiative, children in kindergarten, second and sixth grade, with parental consent, receive a dental screening, dental sealants, and fluoride treatment as needed. This funding covers both under and uninsured children enrolled in participating schools.

This Amendment is to add the application of silver diamine fluoride (SDF) for the management of dental decay. Recently approved for use in arresting dental decay, SDF is a valuable service for children with several active cavity lesions, lesions that may be difficult to treat due to age or behavioral issues or for children without access to or with difficulty accessing dental care. While we are not able to comprehensively treat dental decay in our program, we can help stop the progression of tooth decay and tooth pain until therapeutic services (fillings, crowns) can be completed in the child's dental home.

*Procurement Method:

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

This IGA will continue to address oral health disparities in under served populations. Findings from scientific studies clearly show that school dental sealant programs work to prevent tooth decay and also stop cavities from growing. The Surgeon General's report on oral health indicates that sealants can reduce decay in school children by more than 70 percent. The Task Force on Community Preventive Services recommends school sealant programs and issued a strong endorsement in 2001.

*Public Benefit:

Poor dental health can lead to pain, infection and tooth loss resulting in poor school attendance, low self-esteem, and difficulty with speaking and eating. Services specified by the Dental Sealant IGA are provided in Amphitheater, Flowing Wells, Marana, Tucson and Sunnyside Unified School Districts. Without funding, the Health Department would not have the capacity to provide dental sealant, fluoride, or SDF treatments and many more under insured and uninsured children would have limited access to preventive dental health services.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

- # of dental screenings and sealant placement for children in 2nd or 6th grade
- # of dental screenings and fluoride applications for children in kindergarten
- # of children receiving SDF treatments

*Retroactive:

Yes. This amendment involved a lot of back and forth with the new Procurement Officer at ADHS. The final amendment language was not received until December 20, making the January 16, 2018 BOS meeting the first one available for the Agenda. If the Amendment is not approved, PCHD will be unable to bill for the application of SDF.

ORAL HEALTH DENTAL SEALANT SERVICES

Effective January 1, 2018, it is mutually agreed that the Contract referenced is amended as follows:

Pursuant to the Terms and Conditions, Provision Six (6), Contract Changes; Item 6.1, Amendments, Purchase Orders and Change Orders:

 The Scope of Work, Provision One (1), Background, Paragraphs nine (9) and ten (10) are hereby added to read as follows:

Background:

Silver Diamine Fluoride (SDF) is a colorless liquid containing silver, fluoride and ammonia. In clinical trials, SDF was more effective than fluoride varnish or other fluoride agents at halting the caries process and at arresting decay when applied directly to cavitated lesions. Several clinical trials revealed that SDF is a safe, efficient, and effective method of controlling caries. SDF is an agent that prevents cavitated lesions from further progressing into the dentin of a tooth. It is recommended for use in people who are unable to access dental treatment or tolerate conventional dental care.

SDF, included in the Arizona school-based sealant program, is a great alternative for preventing tooth decay in children residing in low income communities, especially those that lack access to dental care and those that are afraid of going to the dentist. SDF has been proven to be effective at not only arresting active decay, but also at reducing the risk of cavities in the permanent first molars of children. Children participating in the school-based sealant program will benefit greatly from having access to this very innovative approach to treating and preventing tooth decay.
