Pima County Safety and Justice Challenge Qualitative Evaluation

*Purpose:

In partnership with the University of Arizona's Southwest Institute for Research on Women (SIROW), Pima County's Safety and Justice Challenge will receive a qualitative research report that measures the impacts to individuals who have first hand experience with the strategies identified under the MacArthur Foundation Grant to safely lower the county's jail population. UA SIROW's responsibilities are identified under this Agreement, which includes the research project's scope of work and revised timeline.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

To understand, from the perspective of program participants, the success and potential barriers of Pima County's three major strategies.

*Public Benefit:

Pima County is expected to benefit from the data and analysis gathered by the research to determine the impacts of the strategies that have been identified in the grant.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

Design interview protocol, conduct 50 qualitative structured interviews to include individuals who have been screened at jail by Pretrial Services, those who have attended warrants resolution courts, and individuals who have been assigned electronic monitoring as an alternative to jail, transcribe and code interviews, conduct qualitative data analysis, and report on the findings.
