Thank you for meeting with us at the SAC meeting last month. We appreciate your support.

In the upcoming meeting of the Board of Supervisors on 4/17, it is expected that there will be a vote on a proposed amendment to request that \$16 million of bond funds be re-purposed to provide for poor and/or failed arterial and collector road improvements over the next two years; \$10 million for Year 1, and \$6 million for Year 2.

I am Vice President, and Roads Committee Chair for Sunrise Territory Estates HOA (STEHOA), and Website Administrator for Sunrise Association Council (SAC). SAC has representation for "Fairfield in the Foothills" with over 1800 homes on over 1700 Acres in District 1.

I am writing to encourage you to approve the proposed amendment in order to ensure that some of the more critical needs of our county's roads are met.

In addition, I would like to ask for your support that the approximately 1 mile of failed Territory Drive between Grey Man Trail and Craycroft be included in the year 1 list of roads to be repaired from these funds. At a recent SAC meeting, Deputy County Administrator Carmine DeBonis encouraged us that Territory Drive was qualified and in scope for this first year funding plan. BTW - He is doing a great job in improving the business process efficiency and strategic allocation of resources for Pima County.

While I understand that Pima County has significant funding demands for many projects, I would like to encourage you to support the most basic and crucial county services first and foremost. Repairing poor and/or failed roads is unarguably among those essential needs.
