Pima County ("County"), a body politic and corporate of the State of Arizona, and Catholic Community Services of Southern Arizona, Inc. *dba* Community Outreach Program for the Deaf ("Awardee"), a non-profit corporation authorized to do business in the State of Arizona, have entered into the above-referenced contract to provide workforce development services for adults, dislocated workers and youth.

AMENDMENT TWO

- A. County, as Grantee, has a federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Pub.L. 113-128 ("WIOA") grant which ends on June 30, 2020. WIOA funding has been approved for 2018-2019.
- B. County is also the Subrecipient of Health Profession Opportunity Grant ("HPOG") funds from Pima Community College for 2018-2019 and is authorized to pass those funds along to Awardee for training eligible individuals for well-paying, high demand healthcare occupations.

- C. For contract year 2017-2018, enrollment of youth in WIOA eligible activities has, despite recruitment efforts of Awardee, has been lower than expected and demand for adult and dislocated worker services has been greater than expected.
- D. The Pima County Board of Supervisors finds that that revising the work statements for services provided during the contract year 2017-2018 will improve employment opportunities for Pima County residents.
- E. The Pima County Board of Supervisors further finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of to extend the Contract for an additional year to provide services do WIOA and HPOG eligible adults and dislocated workers.
- F. County has reviewed Awardee's performance of the services and finds it satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Awardee agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. SECTION 1.0 - TERMS AND EXTENSIONS, paragraph 1.1 is amended as follows:

1.1. The termination date is changed:

FROM: June 30, 2018

TO: June 30, 2019

1.2. The number of available renewals is changed:

FROM: three (3) additional years or any portion thereof

TO: two (2) additional years or any portion thereof

2. SECTION 3.0 - COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT, is amended as follows:

2.1. Paragraph 3.1 is amended to increase the Maximum Allocated Amount:

FROM: \$190,254.40

TO: \$277,394.13

Changes up to and including 15% of the Total Operating Budget for the current contract year may be granted by and at the sole discretion of the Director of Community Services, Employment and Training (CSET) or his designee. Awardee must submit a written request and show that any proposed increase is offset by a decrease of equal value to the remaining line items. No increase to the total operating budget will be allowed. The change will not be effective, nor will compensation under the change be provided, until the date set forth in the written approval of the Director or his designee.

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3.2. Paragraph 3.10.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Changes of more than 15% of the total budget will require a contract amendment. The change will not be effective, nor will compensation under the change be provided, until the contract amendment is fully executed by both parties.

3.3. Paragraph 3.10.3 is added to read:

Changes between the Total Operating Budget and the Other Allocation(s) line item are not allowed.
