#### \*Purpose:

Pima Animal Care Center (PACC) will use these grant funds to expand and support our already existent Kitten Memory Care program.

# \*Procurement Method:

Grant award - procurement exempt per BOS Policy D29.4.V

# \*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The goal of this program is to find non-traditional foster and adoption placement for vulnerable animals in need of specialized care. These funds will be applied to the purchase of supplies, medical care and transportation of neonatal kittens. This award is considered "lifesaving funds" and is invested in animal welfare organizations for operations, programs and partnerships that reduce the number of animals in shelters being needlessly euthanized and do so in a responsible and sound manner. The grant award is unrestricted and may be used in any manner so long as the purpose is to responsibly achieve a reduction in euthanasia of companion animals in the United States.

#### \*Public Benefit:

By placing pets in non-traditional adoption and foster settings, PACC is better able to provide better care to the pets in our shelter, potentially saving more lives and reducing costs to Pima County.
