*Purpose:

This amendment with subrecipient SER is designed to continue workforce development services to Pima County adult, dislocated worker and veteran job seekers who are seeking employment or job skills training that can lead to employment. SER will provide work experience, case management, and support services to assist adult, dislocated worker and veteran job seekers in finding employment. The Kino Veteran's Workforce Center serves up to 500 veterans annually by providing counseling, placing veterans into appropriate job skills training, and making referrals to job opportunities plus providing information on the variety of services available to veterans.

This amendment will provide additional funding and extend the contract for another year for the period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

("Awardee"), a non-profit corporation registered to do business in the State of Arizona have entered into the above-referenced contract to provide workforce veterans and innovation services.

AMENDMENT TWO

- County, as Grantee, received federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Pub.L.113-128 A. ("WIOA") grant funds for the operation of the Pima County ARIZONA@WORK Career Center System Workforce Program. The WIOA grant ends June 30, 2020.

- C. County, as Grantee, received grant funds from the U.S. Department of Labor ("USDOL") Veterans Employment and Training Services ("VETS") for the Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program ("HVRP").
- D. County is also the Subrecipient of Health Profession Opportunity Grant ("HPOG") funds from Pima Community College and is authorized to pass those funds along to Awardee for eligible services.
- E. The Pima County Board of Supervisors finds that that extending this Contract will improve employment opportunities for Pima County veterans and is in the best interests of the veterans of Pima County.
- F. Funds have been awarded to County from the WIOA, HPOG and HVRP grants for services in FY2018-2019.
- G. County has reviewed Awardee's performance of the services and finds it satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Awardee agree to amend the Contract as follows:
