Introduction/Background:

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Section 107(b)(2) requires the following criteria for the **WIB Composition**:

- ✓ A majority of the WIB must be Pima County Business representatives;
- ✓ Not less than 20 percent of the members must be Workforce representatives;
- ✓ Must include a **Title II Adult Education and Literacy** representative;
- ✓ Must include a **Higher Education** representative from institution providing workforce investment activities (including community colleges);
- ✓ Must include representatives of Governmental and Economic and Community Development (GECD) entities;
- ✓ Must include an appropriate **Title III State Employment Service Office** representative under the Wagner-Peyser Act; and
- ✓ Must include an appropriate **Title IV Vocational Rehabilitation Services** representative of the programs carried out under Title I of the Rehabilitation Act.

Discussion:

Seven WIB members' Reappointment Terms were approved during the 11/07/2017 Pima County Board of Supervisors' Regular Meeting. One additional WIB member, Aric L.
